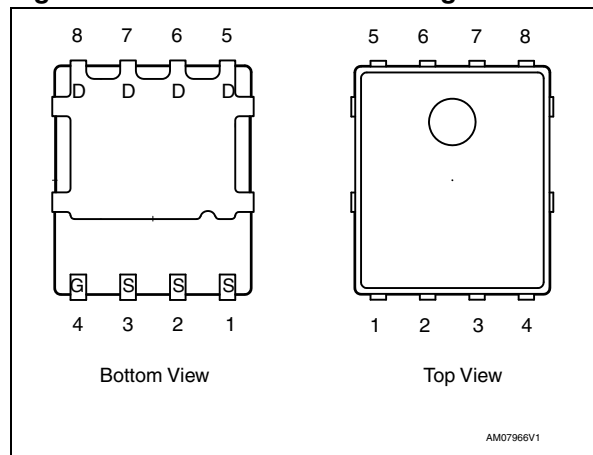

Figure 2. Safe operating area

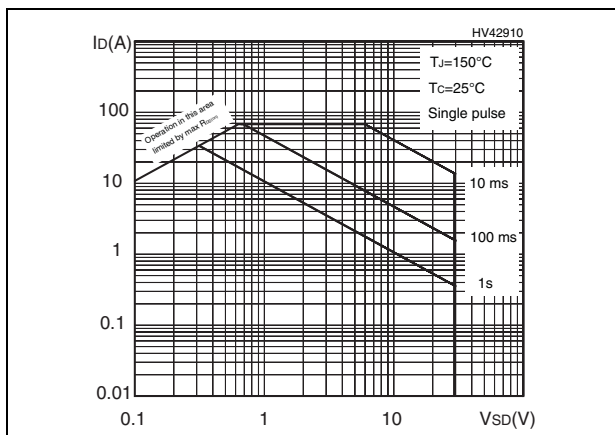


Figure 3. Thermal impedance

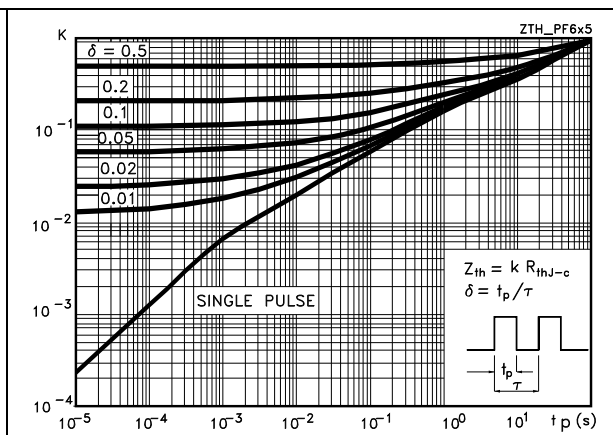


Figure 4. Output characteristics

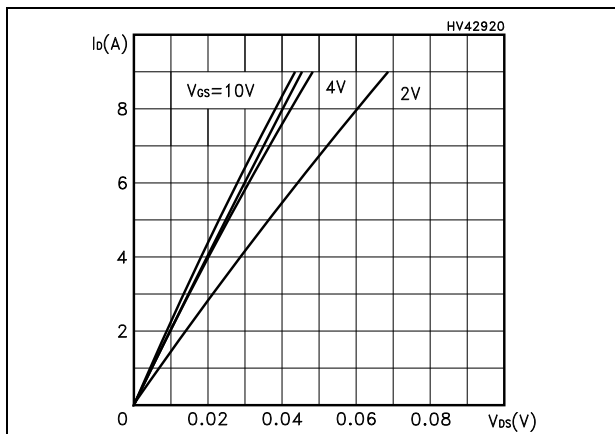


Figure 5. Transfer characteristics

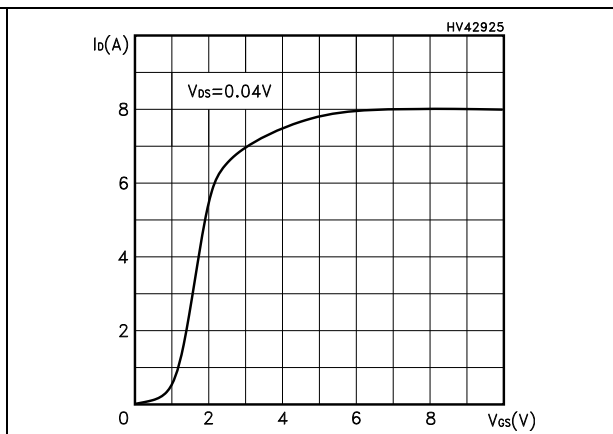


Figure 6. Normalized BV<sub>DSS</sub> vs temperature

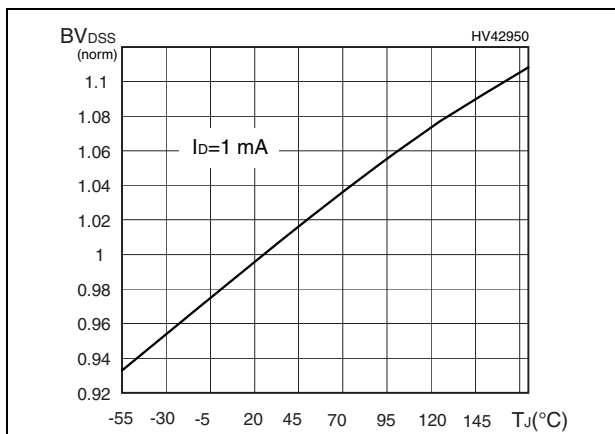


Figure 7. Static drain-source on resistance

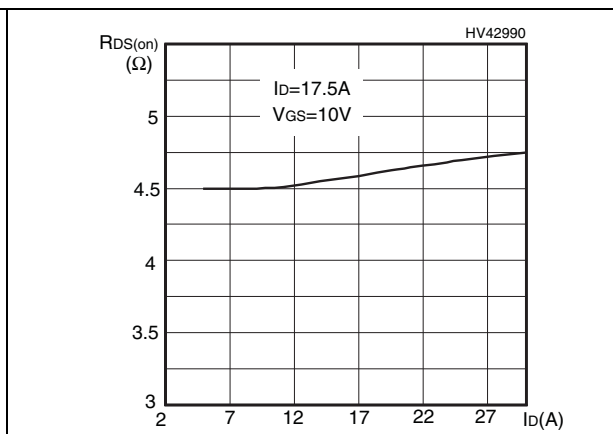


Figure 8. Gate charge vs gate-source voltage Figure 9. Capacitance variations

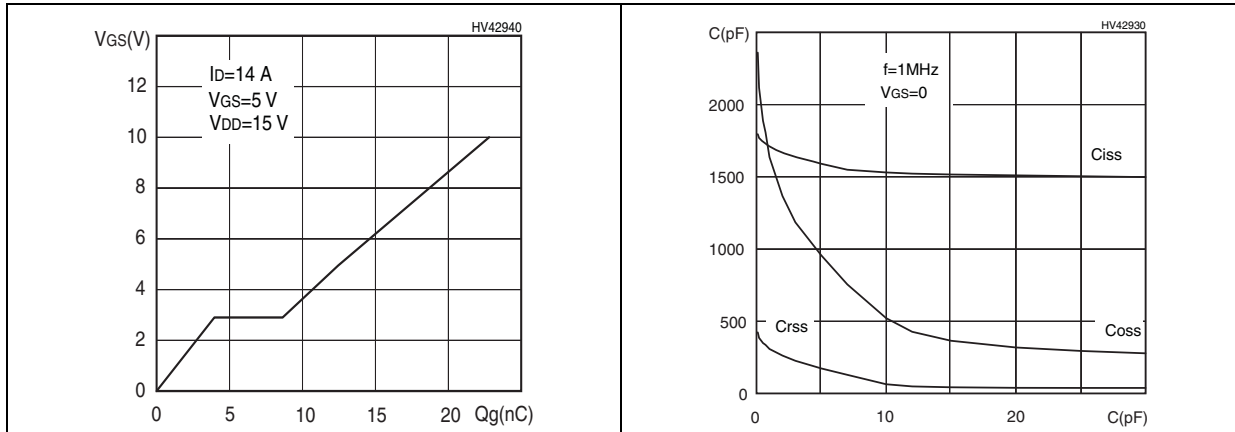


Figure 10. Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature Figure 11. Normalized on resistance vs temperature

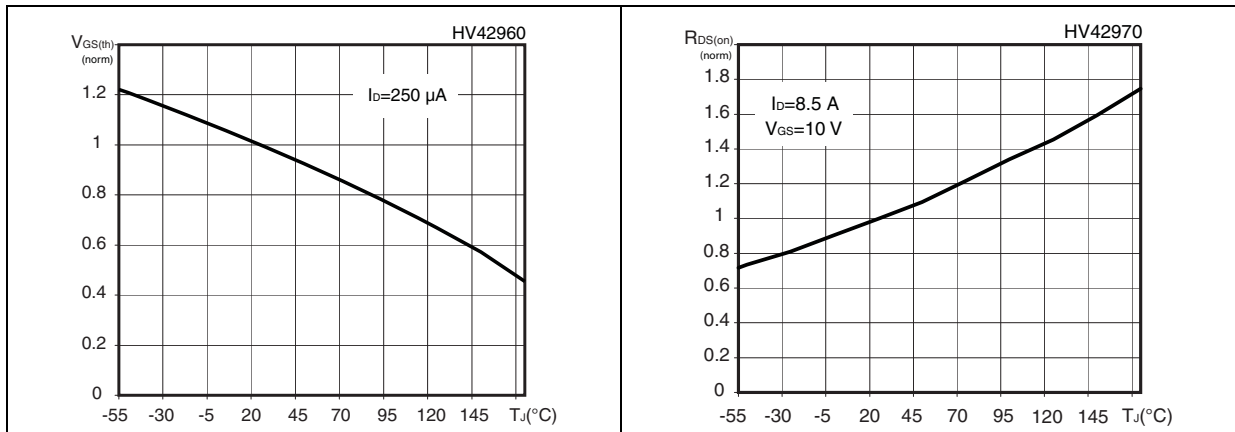
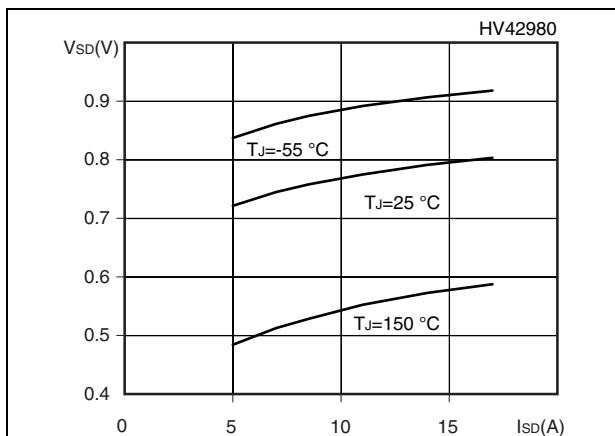


Figure 12. Source-drain diode forward characteristics

**Figure 15. Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times**



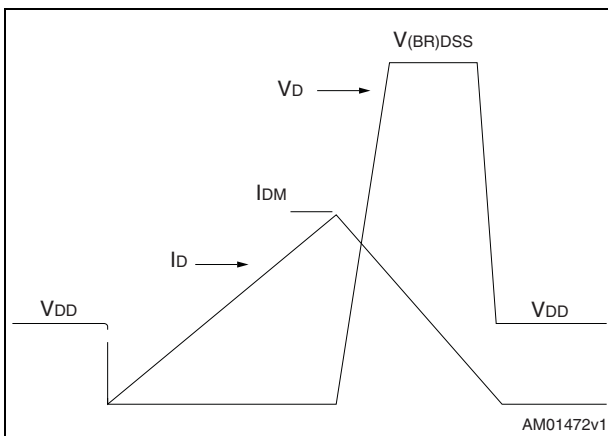

**Figure 16. Unclamped inductive load test circuit**



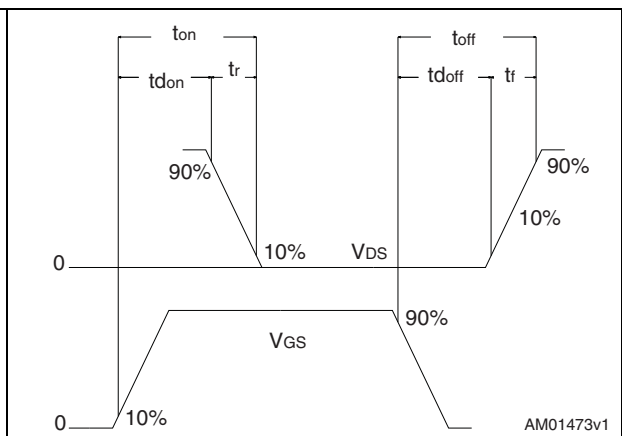

Figure 19. PowerFLAT™ 5x6 type C-B drawing

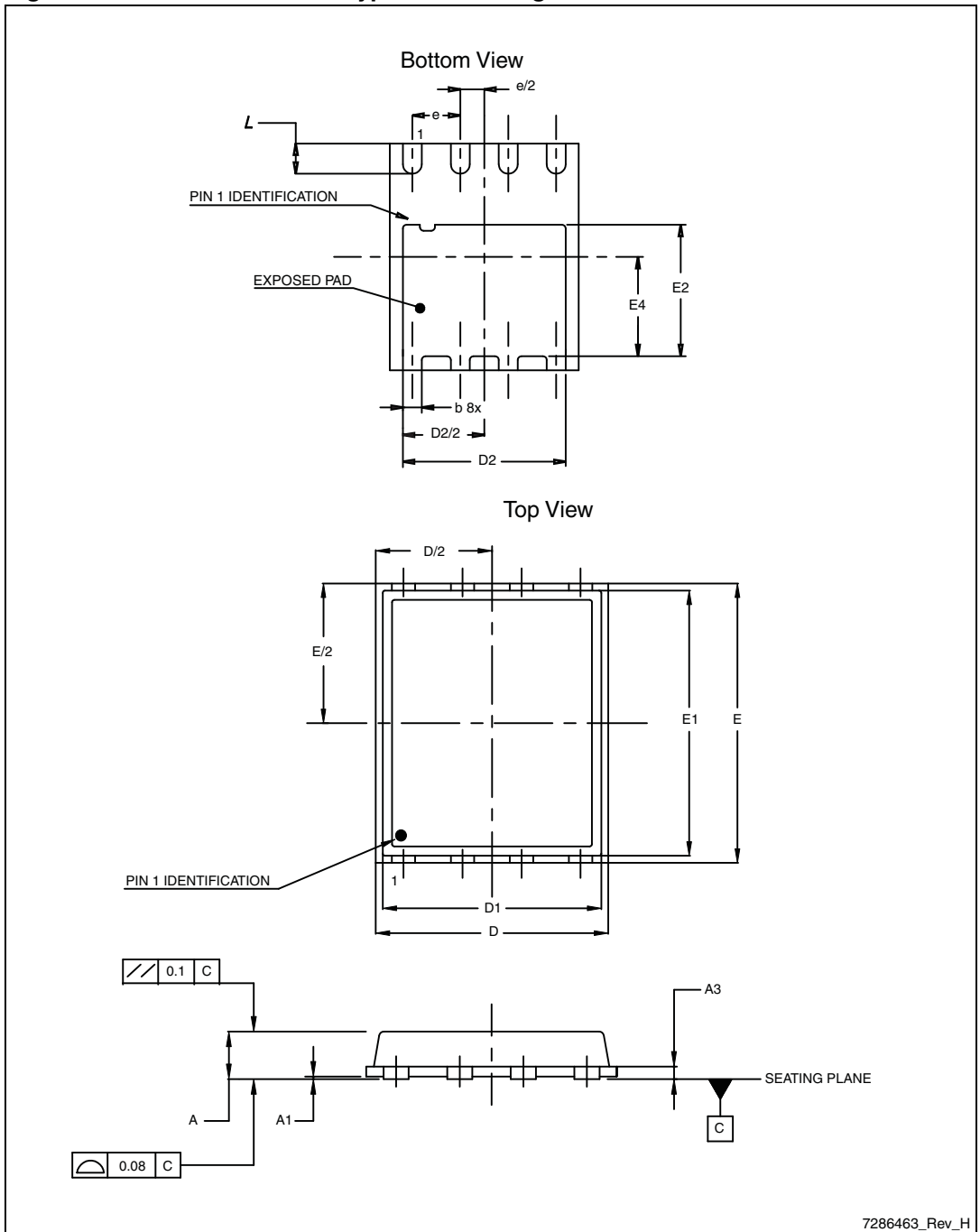

Figure 20. PowerFLAT™ 5x6 type S-C mechanical data

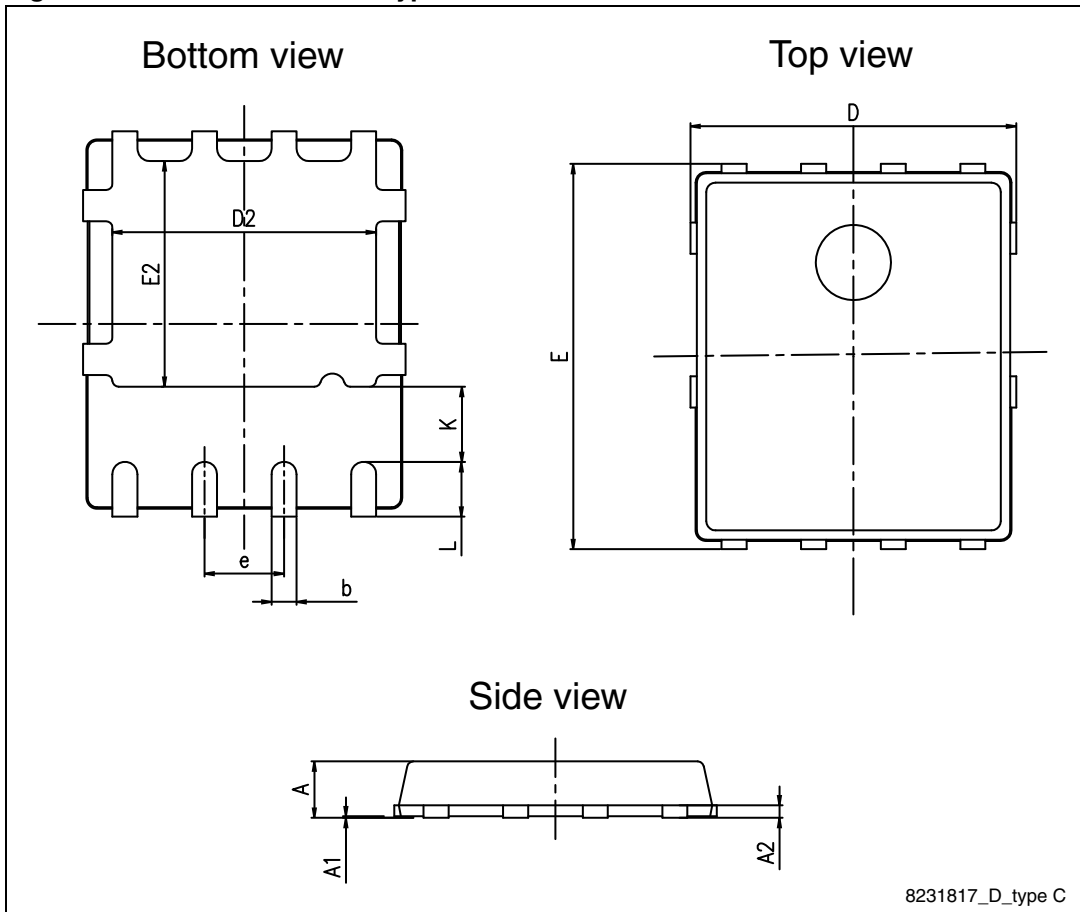
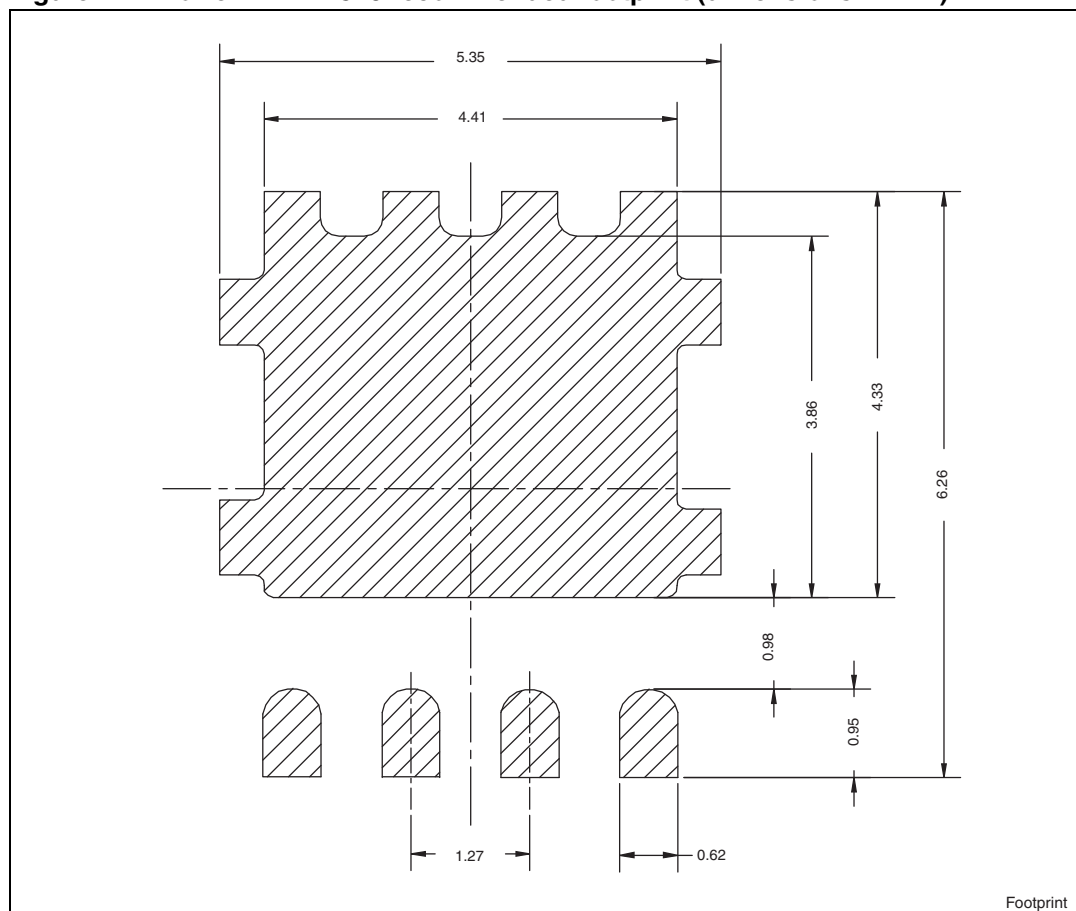


Figure 21. PowerFLAT™ 5x6 recommended footprint (dimensions in mm)
