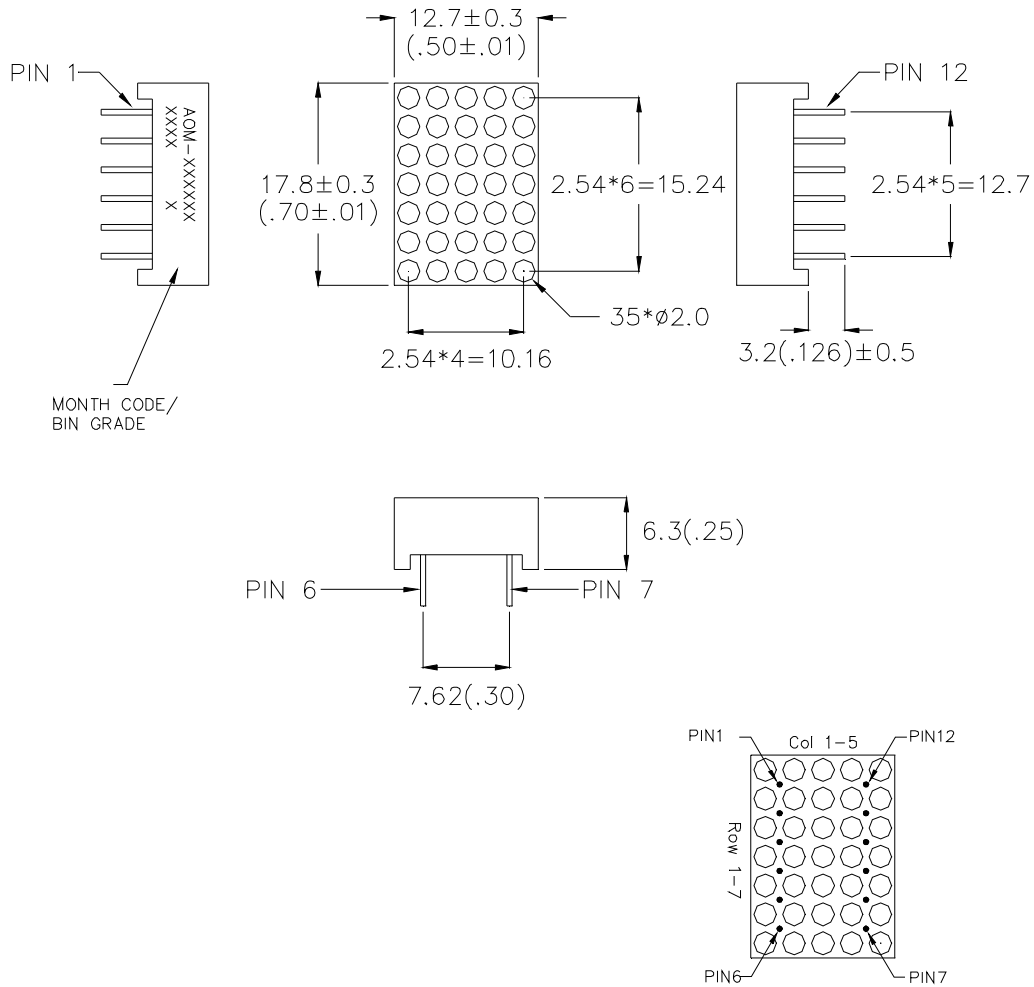

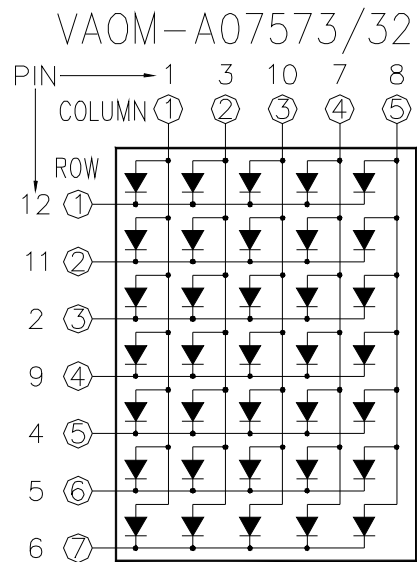
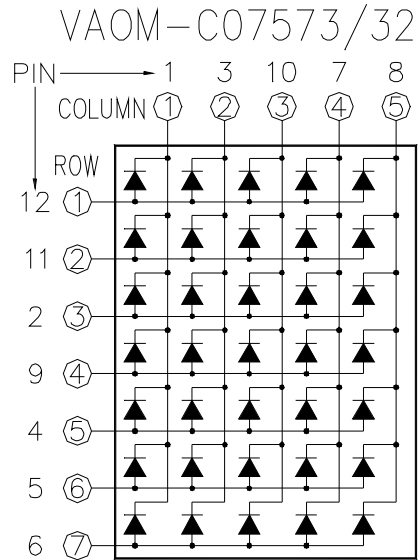

Typical Electro-optical Characteristic Curves (25°C Free Air Temperature Unless Otherwise Specified)

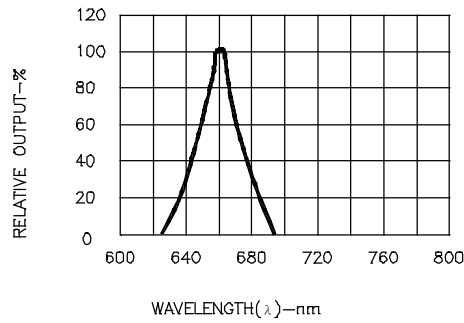


Fig.1 SPECTRAL RESPONSE

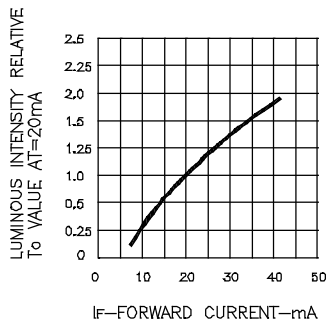


Fig.2 RELATIVE LUMINOUS INTENSITY VS. FORWARD CURRENT

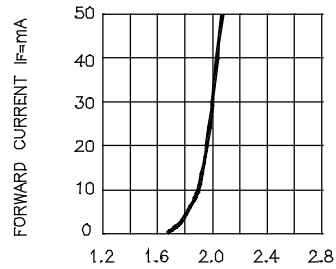


Fig.3 FORWARD CURRENT VS FORWARD VOLTAGE

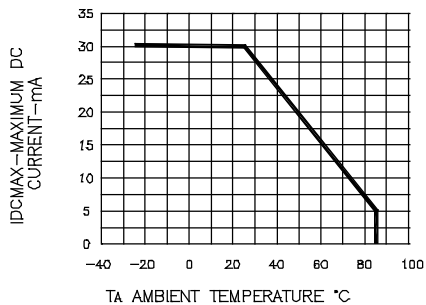


Fig.4 MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE DC CURRENT PER SEGMENT VS. A FUNCTION OF AMBIENT TEMPERATURE
