

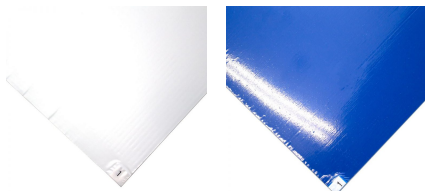
First-Step Tack Mat
