1. General description

Standard level N-channel MOSFET in an LFPAK56 (Power SO8) package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to AEC Q101 standard for use in high performance automotive applications.




Fig. 1. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature

$$V_{GS} \ge 10V$$




Fig. 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature

$$P_{der} = \frac{P_{tot}}{P_{tot(25^{\circ}C)}} \times 100\%$$

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



Fig. 3. Avalanche rating; avalanche current as a function of avalanche time






Fig. 4. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage

 $T_{mb} = 25^{\circ}C; \ I_{DM}$ is a single pulse






Fig. 6. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig. 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; I_D = 20A$$




Fig. 8. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values






Fig. 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ V_{DS} = 5V$$





Fig. 9. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 11. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig. 12. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

$$a = \frac{R_{DSon}}{R_{DSon (25^{\circ}C)}}$$




Fig. 14. Gate charge waveform definitions




Fig. 13. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ I_D = 20A$$




Fig. 15. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

$$V_{GS} = \mathbf{0}V; \ f = \mathbf{1}MHz$$





Fig. 16. Source (diode forward) current as a function of source-drain (diode forward) voltage; typical values
