




Fig 1. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of junction temperature


Fig 3. Safe operating area; junction to ambient; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage







Fig 6. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



Fig 8. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values





Fig 7. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage



Fig 10. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values






Fig 11. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance as a function of ambient temperature; typical values


Fig 12. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

Fig 13. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



Fig 15. Gate charge waveform definitions









Fig 18. Package outline SOT416 (SC-75)
