





Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics






Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operation Area




Figure 11. E<sub>OSS</sub> vs. Drain to Source Voltage




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variant vs. Temperature




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve




Figure 13. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform




Figure 14. Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure 15. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




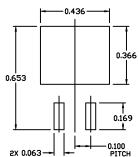
Figure 16. Peak Diode Recovery dt/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms
