- STM32F303VCT6 microcontroller featuring 256-Kbyte Flash memory and 48-Kbyte RAM in an LQFP100 package
- USB FS
- ST MEMS motion sensor, 3-axis digital output gyroscope
- ST MEMS system-in-package featuring a 3D digital linear acceleration sensor and a 3D digital magnetic sensor
- Ten LEDs:
  - LD1 (red) for 3.3 V power on

# **Description**

The STM32F3DISCOVERY allows users to easily develop applications with the STM32F3 Series mixed-signal microcontroller based on the Arm<sup>®</sup> Cortex<sup>®</sup>-M4. It includes everything required for beginners and experienced users to get started quickly.

Based on the STM32F303VCT6, it includes an ST-LINK/V2 or ST-LINK/V2-B embedded debug tool, accelerometer, gyroscope and e-compass ST MEMS, USB connection, LEDs and push-buttons.

The STM32F3DISCOVERY runs with the STM32F303VC 32-bit microcontroller based on the Arm<sup>®</sup> Cortex<sup>®</sup>-M4 core.

# 2.3 Demonstration software

The demonstration software, included in the STM32Cube MCU Package corresponding to the on-board microcontroller, is preloaded in the STM32 Flash memory for easy demonstration of the device peripherals in standalone mode. It uses the USER push-button to switch the operation of the eight LEDs into different modes from simple blinking mode, to indicate the gyroscope movements, or the direction of the North Pole.
