






Fig. 7.1 V<sub>I(on)</sub> - I<sub>O</sub>




Fig. 7.2 Io - V<sub>I(off)</sub>





Fig. 7.3 I<sub>O</sub> - V<sub>O</sub>

Fig. 7.5  $V_{O(on)}$  -  $I_O$ 

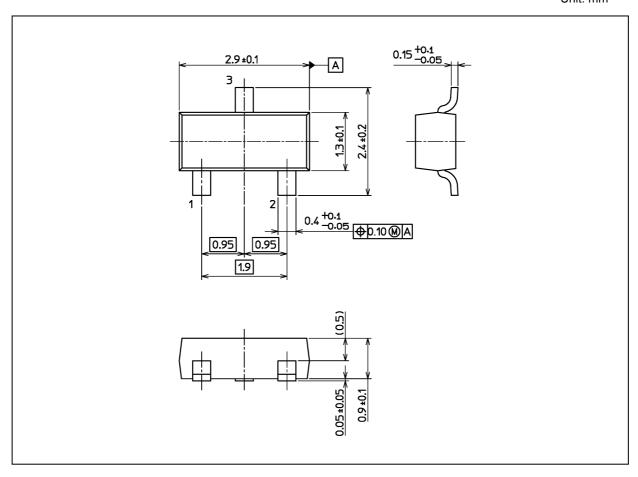
