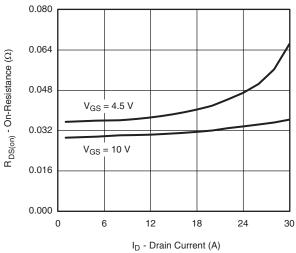

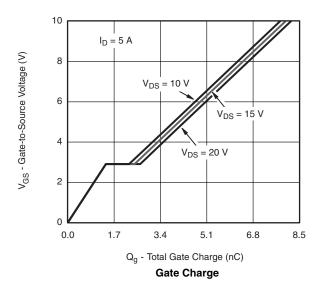


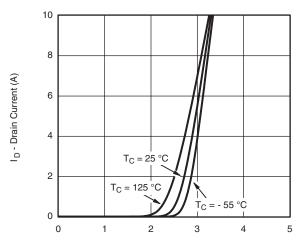
 V_{DS} - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V)

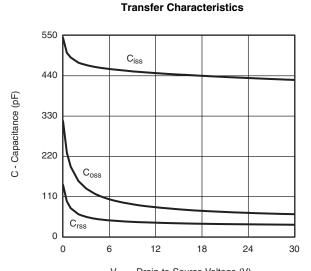


On-Resistance vs. Drain Current



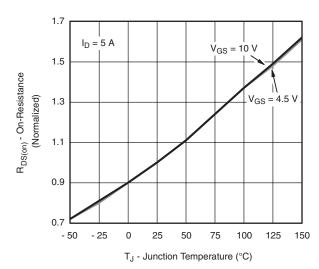


 $V_{\mbox{\footnotesize GS}}$ - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V)

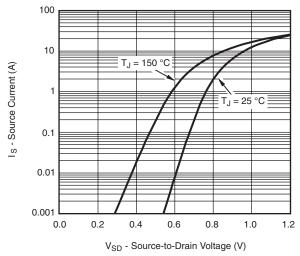


On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

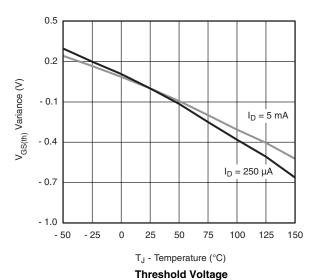
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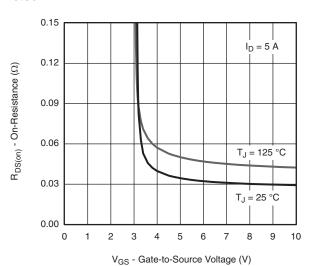

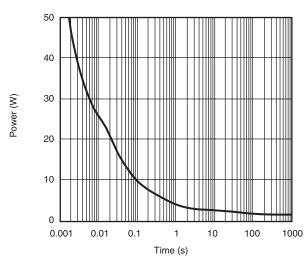


Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

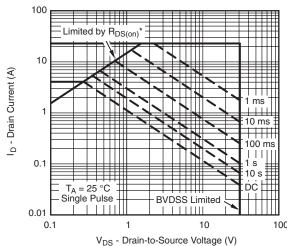




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Single Pulse Power



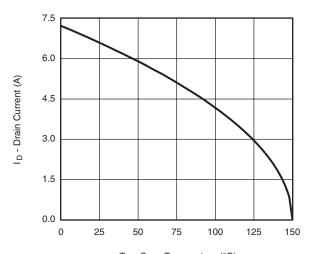

Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient



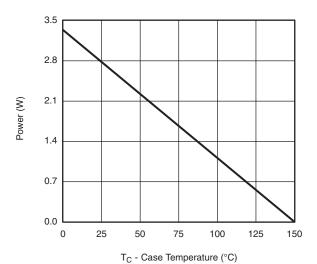
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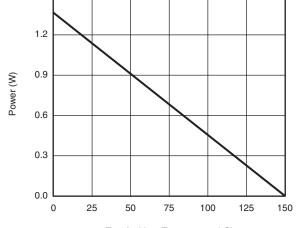

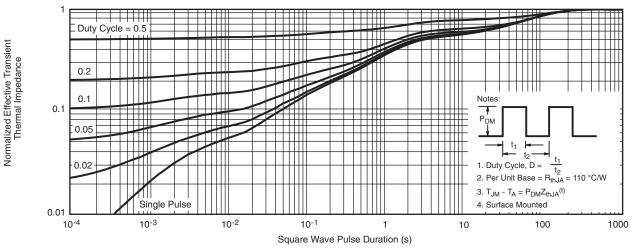

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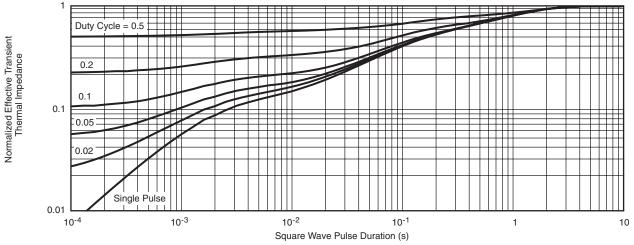

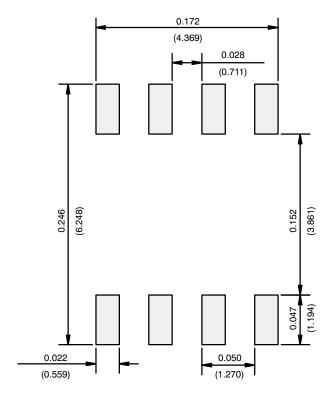
