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
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### RATINGS AND CHARACTERISTICS CURVES (T<sub>A</sub> = 25 °C unless otherwise noted)






Fig. 3 - Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics





Fig. 4 - Typical Reverse Leakage Characteristics






Fig. 6 - Typical Transient Thermal Impedance

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
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
